Objectives of the course	<p>Acquire basic communicative competence in Spanish:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand oral and written texts about topics that personally as well as professionally interest students; and produce both oral and written messages related to their communicative interest. • Interact in such a way that they are understood in communicative situations that are familiar to them, using simple and basic sentences. • To deepen their knowledge of their own socio-cultural reality by confronting what they know with aspects of Spanish culture and civilization of people from the Spanish speaking world. • Show the benefits of learning the Spanish language instead of other languages spoken in the world. • Develop in students the capacity to show initiative, to have good decision-making skills, to be responsible and autonomous. 		
Entry requirements	Students should already possess A2 level of Spanish.		
Course contents	<p>The syllabus is organised into five modules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Health and wellness; * Types of tourism/ tourism options; * The tourism professional / tourism sectors; * Travelling: transportation and other touristic information; * Tourist accommodations; * Festivals and tourist destinations/ tourist itineraries in Spain and Latin America.
